Academic course working programs were monitored to establish the availability of testing and assessment materials (TAM) designed for the interim assessment (IA) of 2019-2020 academic year. The IA were designed for "Psychology" Bachelor Degree Program, "Conflict Resolution Studies" Bachelor Degree Program, "Clinical Psychology" and "Employment Activity Psychology" Specialist's Degree Programs, 7 Psychology Master Degree Programs: "Psychology of Personality", "Developmental Psychology", "Social and Political Psychology", "Mental Health", "Organizational Psychology and Management Psychology", and 3 Conflict Resolution Studies Master Degree Programs: "Conflict Analysis and Management", "Mediation", "Political Conflict Resolution Studies", 2 Psychology PhD Programs: "Psychology and "Clinical Psychology". Total, 16 educational programs were examined.

Analytical conclusions:

- The necessary competencies can be assessed by assessment materials provided in the course programs
